LAST MINUTE VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT DROPOFFS

Pima County Recorder F. Ann Rodriguez would like to remind voters that if they still have their vote-by-mail ballots, they can be dropped off at **ANY** polling location on Election Day, Tuesday, November 4, 2014.

If you've already mailed in your vote-by-mail ballot, you can check the status on the Recorder's website at www.recorder.pima.gov under Early Ballot Status.

The Recorder's Office has mailed out approximately **309,700** vote-by-mail ballots to voters in Pima County. Ballot returns as of Monday, November 3, 2014 at 3:30 p.m., broken down by party, are as follows:
